Re: Norfolk Constabulary: Anti-Social Behaviour Awareness Webinar for Y ear 6

We are writing to inform you that Year 6 students will be participating in a webinar for **Anti-Social Behaviour Awareness Week**. This will take place at school on **Friday 22nd November 2024** and will include a webinar presented by **Norfolk Constabulary's Youth Engagement Team** alongside a Safer Schools Police Officer.

The webinar has been specifically designed for Year 6 students and will introduce students to the role of police, discuss what constitutes anti-social behaviour (ASB), and emphasise that certain behaviours are not only harmful but can also have legal consequences.

The webinar will include:

- **Defining ASB**: Students will explore the meaning of anti-social behaviour, with real-life examples to enhance understanding.
- Types of ASB: Students will learn about personal, nuisance, and environmental ASB through interactive tasks.
- Age of Responsibility: The session will cover the age of criminal responsibility to help students understand the implications of certain behaviours.
- Reflection and Advice: Students will be encouraged to reflect on any personal experiences with ASB, whether as witnesses or participants, and will be given guidance on handling situations involving ASB, whether they are involved or are victims.
